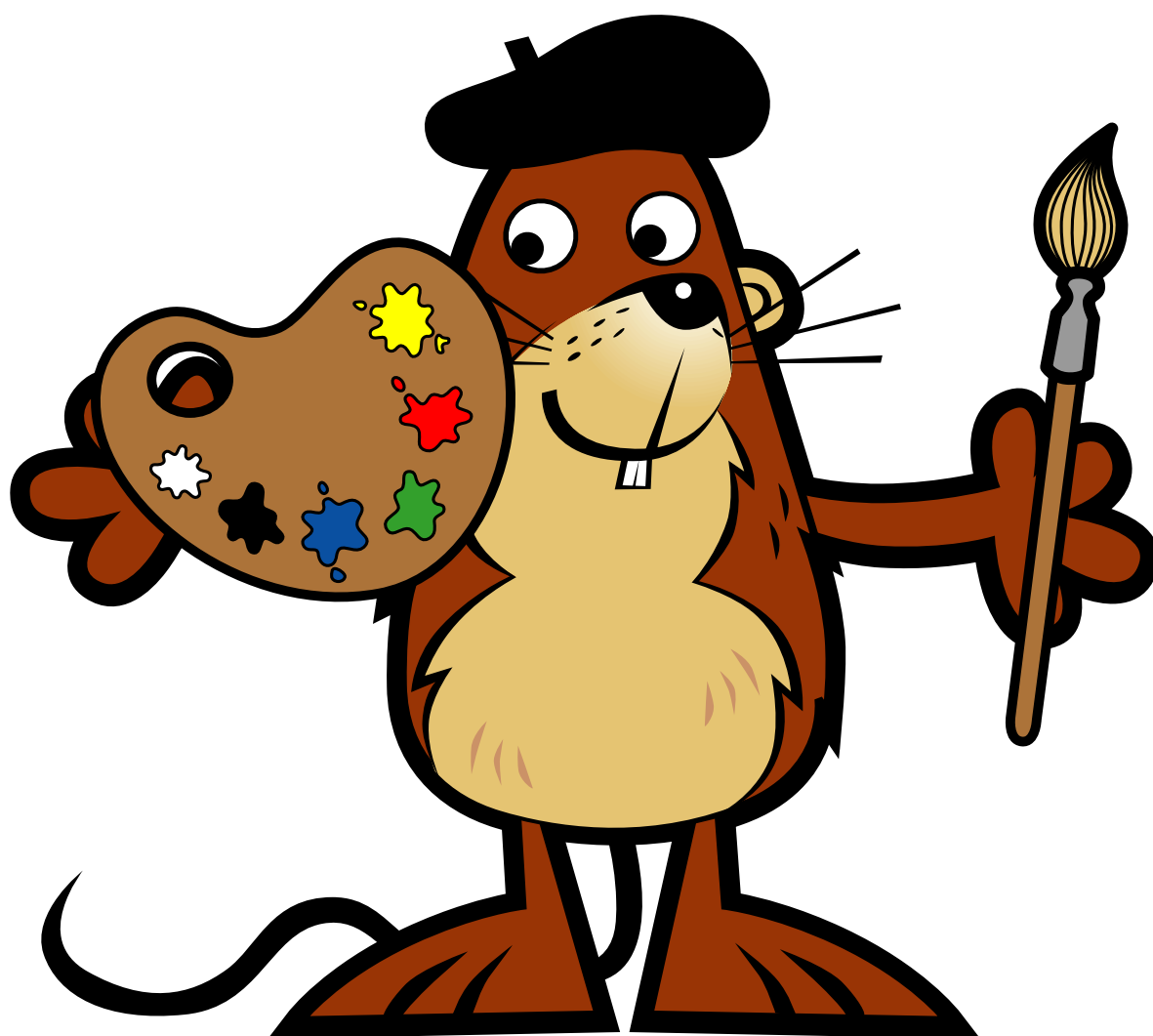
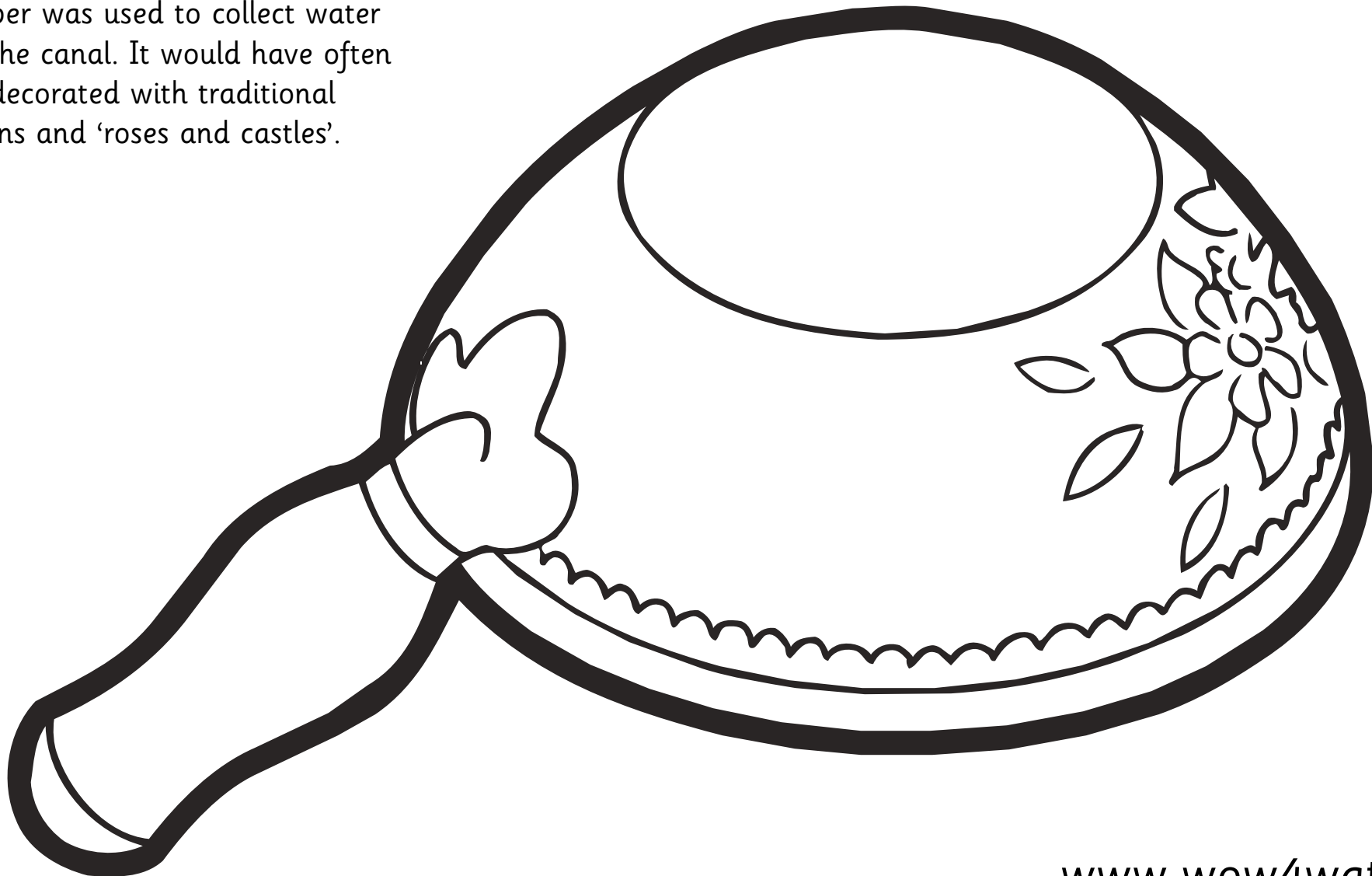
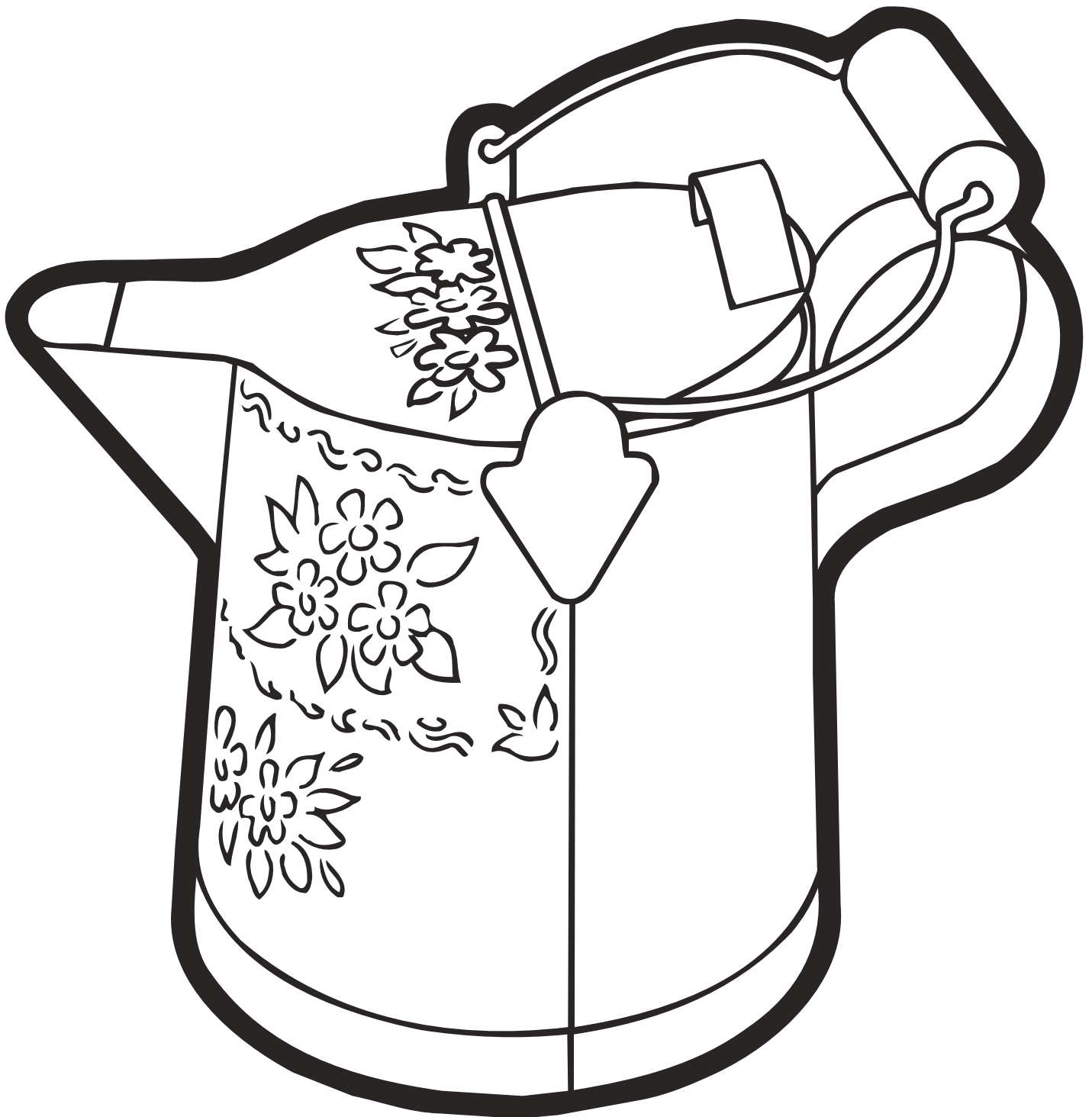


Sharpen your pencils
